STATE CET CELL/ REOPENING THE EDITING AND OPTION GIVING LINK FOR LL.B-5 Yrs. and LL.B-3 Yrs. Dated 04/03/2021

Notice.

Reopening the Editing and option link and rescheduling Round II for LL.B.-5 and LL.B.-3 Yrs.

CET CELL had given the opportunity to the Candidates to edit their application form and change the documents. As per the following Schedule:-

In spite of the various opportunities given, the candidates have not corrected their status. Many candidates are on hold during the E-scrutiny. Candidates have complained that in the first scrutiny the form was approved and was put on hold in the second scrutiny after grievance period.

Since the Second round is the last on line round and most of the seats will be filled in this round, we are making a two day window open to the candidates to edit application form, upload documents and change options.

No E-verification will be done after the candidate has submitted the application form. System will put the remark "Application provisionally approved as submitted by the Candidate.

Candidates who do not edit their application form, their E-scrutiny remarks will be retained as it is.

Candidates are advised to edit the application form, match it with the documents uploaded and upload documents like:-

- 1) All Years' / Semesters Marks Memo and Conversion certificate ,
- 2) Caste Validity Certificate by removing the Caste validity receipt.
- 3) If CVC/NCL/ EWS certificate is not available then the candidate has to remove the category documents and convert the application form to open if they are eligible.
- 4) Various documents/formats are shared in the download sections on the admission portal like conversion Proforma for multiple attempt SSC/HSC, Conversion for Yearly pattern, Conversion for Semester Pattern, Minority related documents like Birth Certificate, School Leaving Certificate mentioning Religion/ Language and place of birth/ Proforma 'O' or Pass port for OMS candidates only if Domicile or Birth

Certificate is not available. The instructions and the detailed list of documents required given in the information brochure

- 5) In no Case Aadhaar Card is to be uploaded as the document for proof.
- 6) Candidates whose marks memo do not have aggregate marks for SSC and HSC and candidates who have qualified SSC and HSC in multiple attempts must upload the conversion certificate applicable to their case.
- 7) The Aggregate marks of All Years/Semesters of the qualifying examinations are to be filled by the candidate. If the aggregate marks of all semesters and years are not mentioned in the final marks memo the candidate has to prepare and upload conversion certificate along with marks memo. There is Hon. Bombay High Court order on record for this which is mentioned in the Information Brochure.
- 8) The number of candidates who have not uploaded CVC/NCL/EWS certificate is as follows:

- 9) E-scrutiny has shown that the candidates have not removed the receipt of NCL/CVC/EWS from the application form.
- 10) Candidates who have received CVC/EWS, NCL certificate should upload the same and take advantage of this extension.
- 11) Most of the candidates who have applied on the basis of reservation are not eligible as per the eligibility criteria of Open Category, so their application forms are on hold.
- 12) Candidates need to update their CVC/EWS/NCL to take advantage of the Category or transfer form to Open if they are eligible as per the eligibility criteria then only they will be considered for allocation in round II.

The Allocation for round II, will be made on the basis of newly submitted application forms and final verification will be done at the level of admitting college and if the college rejects the candidate, the candidate will have to edit the application form before Institutional Level Round for vacant seats after CAP. Final detailed scrutiny as per the document list given in the information brochure will be the responsibility of the admitting college. The admitting college decision will be final. If the Candidate is rejected on scrutiny at the Admitting college, it will be the responsibility of the Candidate only. Hence the candidate should exercise utmost care.

Revised dates for Editing Application form, declaration of Final Merit List and Second Round Allocation will be as follows:-
